

Our program offers state-of-the-art care in the detection, diagnosis, and treatment of disorders affecting the colon, rectum, and anus including:

- Colon cancer
- Rectal cancer
- Colorectal adenoma
- Crohn's disease
- Ulcerative colitis
- Diverticulitis
- Anal and rectal disease (hemorrhoids, polyps, fissures, and abscesses)

Minimally invasive surgery has a range of benefits, including decreased post-operative pain, shorter post-operative recovery time, and less noticeable scarring. Our surgeons perform the following procedures:

- Laparoscopic colon resection
- Robotic surgery for rectal cancer and treatment of other colorectal disorders
- J-pouch procedure for inflammatory bowel disease
- TransAnal Minimally Invasive Surgery (TAMIS) for the removal of rectal polyps not amenable to colonoscopic removal
